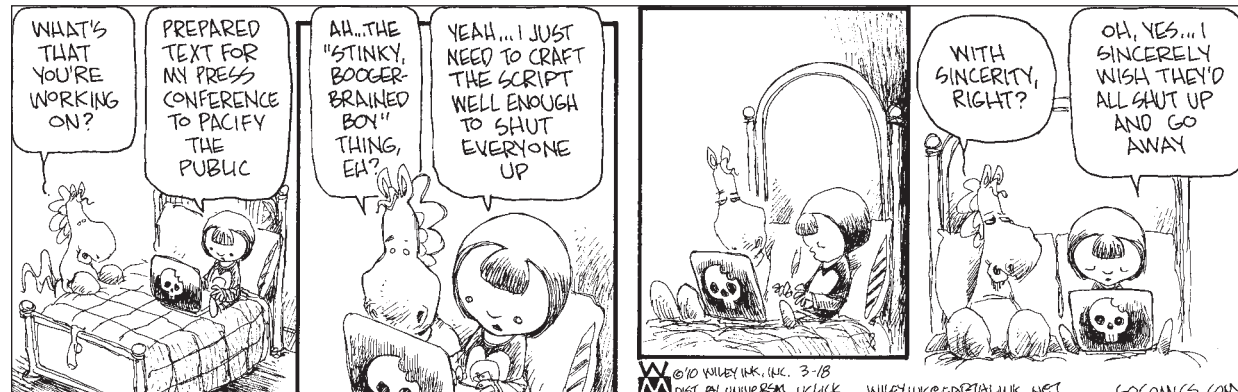

When the opponents miss the mark in the bidding, it is time to cash in. Look at only the North and East hands. You are East, defending against five diamonds. West leads a fourth-highest club two. After winning with your ace, what would you do next?

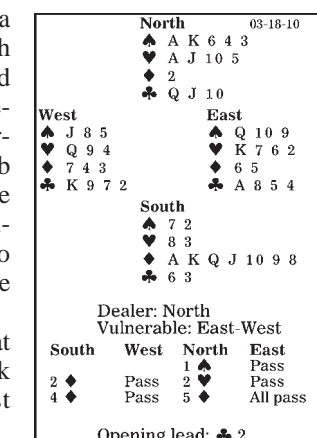
Playing two-over-one game-forcing, South would probably upgrade his hand to a game-force, and could rebid three diamonds. Then North would probably shoot out three

no-trump. Playing Standard, perhaps South should settle for a game-invitational three diamonds. True, North might pass, but he might continue with three no-trump — a contract that would not tax many players! Against five diamonds, East could anticipate two club tricks. A trump trick wouldn't run away. But if South's trumps were solid, the third defensive trick couldn't come from spades; South would have raised that suit with three-card support. The setting trick would have to come from hearts.

East's first thought was to return a club to his partner's king for a heart shift through dummy's ace. Then East realized that, with this defense, South probably wouldn't lose a major-suit trick. If South had seven diamonds and two clubs, as seemed likely, he had only four major-suit cards. After a club return, South would have four winners in the dummy for those cards: two top spades, the heart ace and the club queen.

Taking a slight risk that their second club trick would disappear, East switched to the heart two.

Partner came through, playing his queen. The third defensive trick had been established before the club king was driven out.
